7. What is Risk Reducing Salpingo-Oophorectomy (RRSO). Who are the candidates for RRSO. What are the alternatives if the patient eligible for RRSO declines removal of the ovaries. (3+3+4)
8. A 38 years old parous woman underwent LLETZ for the treatment of CIN3. The final histology shows positive margins. How will you manage this patient.
9. How will you prevent injury to the ureter during radical hysterectomy
