Briefly describe one common chemotherapy regimen used concurrently with radiotherapy in patients with carcinoma cervix. Discuss the role of adjuvant chemotherapy in patients receiving concurrent chemoradiation for cervical cancer. (4+8+8)

2. Discuss the role of Hyperthermic Intra-Peritoneal Chemotherapy (HIPEC) in the management of advanced epithelial cancer of the ovary.
3. Why is carboplatin preferred over cisplatin in the treatment of serous carcinoma of the ovary. How is the dose of carboplatin calculated in a patient for the treatment of epithelial ovarian cancer. (4+6)
4. How will you treat a patient of choriocarcinoma with brain metastasis.
5. Justify primary chemo-radiotherapy in the treatment of stage IB3 cervical cancer.
6. Describe the role of radiotherapy in the management of locally advanced vulval cancer.
7. How will you manage a case of stage IIIC1r cervical cancer who has been found to have residual disease 3 months after completion of chemoradiation.
8. How will you manage sarcoma botryoids of the vagina in a 9-year-old girl who has presented with profuse vaginal bleeding.
9. How will you manage a stage II grade I endometrioid endometrial cancer patient who had recently undergone appropriate oncological surgery.

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
