## NOTIFICATION

**Subject: Inviting applications for M.Sc Medical Bioinformatics – 2 year full-time programme at School of Translational Health Sciences, KUHS Headquarters, Thrissur.**

It is hereby notified that the Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) is inviting applications from eligible candidates for pursuing two year full-time Post-Graduate degree program in Medical Bioinformatics through School of Translational Health Sciences in KUHS campus, Thrissur for the academic year 2026-27.

### **2. Eligibility:**

Those who have completed undergraduate degree courses in health science subjects belonging to Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Homeopathy / Nursing / Pharmacy / Allied Health streams from KUHS with 50% marks or courses deemed as equivalent by the University and who have registered under the respective statutory regulatory councils of the state (as applicable).

Note: The student shall not enrol in any other part – time or full-time academic / Research programmes (including part time / full time PhD / MPhil Programmes) / courses which necessitate physical attendance, while pursuing the programme.

### **3. Application Fee**

Application fee, is Rs.2500/- for General category and Rs.2000/- for SC/ST categories. The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

### **4. How to apply**

Applications are to be submitted online till 10.04.2026. Visit the University website [www.kuhs.ac.in](http://www.kuhs.ac.in) and access the Registration Link provided in the **Announcements**.





- Registration requires the following details: Name, Mobile Number, and Email ID.
- Upon successful registration, the Username and Password will be sent to the registered Email ID.
- The candidate should log in using the login name and password and should submit the online application.

The submission of online application includes the following steps:

Step 1:

- Submit personal information
- Submit qualification details
- Upload Photo and Signature
- Upload attested copies of academic documents such as SSLC (proof of age), Plus Two, Degree certificate, Degree Mark list (consolidated), Transfer Certificate from Institution,
- Upload Nativity Certificate, Community Certificate, Non-creamy layer Certificate, Disability Certificate(for PwD candidates), Council Registration certificate(as applicable).

- The application of candidate will be considered only if they successfully submit their application and upload required documents through online application portal on or before 10.04.2026 (5.00 PM).
- Applications received after the closure date will not be entertained.

## 8. Selection process

- The Selection of candidates for the course is based on the entrance examination conducted by the university and in accordance with the state government's reservation policy.
- The question papers for Entrance Examination will consist of objective type multiple choice questions that assess the subject knowledge with total marks of 50.
- The questions will be focussing on
  - Basics Health Science subjects and research methodology - 35 marks
  - Biotechnology, Bioinformatics & Computer Science - 5 marks each.
  - The time duration of the entrance examination is 60 minutes.
- The rank list will be published based on the entrance examination. Admission memo will be issued to selected candidates

## 9. Fee structure

- The Tuition fee is Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand Rupees) per candidate per semester. The Tuition



fees should be paid at the beginning of each semester.

- In addition, students shall remit a one-time fee of Rs. 3885/- (Three Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Five Only) towards Admission fee (including Student Registration fee, Certificate Verification, Identity card, University Union fee and Sports fee) and Rs. 30,000/- towards Caution Deposit along with the fee for First semester.
- The examination fee will be fixed by the University from time to time and should be remitted by the students separately at the time of exam registration.

## 10. Execution of Bond

A bond in the prescribed format for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) shall be executed by the student at the time of registration to the Programme.

## 11. General Conditions

1. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the notification and course prospectus.
2. Application Forms not complying with the instructions are liable to be rejected.
3. Only Indian nationals are eligible to apply for these programmes. Applicants whose place of birth and/or prior education is from a foreign country must submit supporting evidence, such as Indian passport. If, at any point during or after admission, it is found that the candidate is not a citizen of India, their admission will be forfeited, and they shall be subjected to legal action as per law.
4. Only candidates who are natives of Kerala are eligible for communal reservation. Non-Keralites will be treated as General Category candidates. The applicants must produce a valid nativity certificate from the competent authority of Kerala to prove that they are natives of Kerala.
5. Those candidates who had completed their qualifying examination from other Universities shall produce an eligibility certificate from KUHS at the time of admission.
6. Eligible relaxation in cut-off marks of the entrance examination shall be applicable for SC/ST categories.
7. The candidate should produce all the original documents required by the University at the time of admission for verification purpose, failing which, their candidature for admission will be forfeited and admission shall be cancelled at any stage.
8. Candidates eligible for reservation should submit their application in the relevant category. If a candidate has applied under the General Category, he/she will be treated as General, even if, he/she is eligible to apply under the reservation category.
9. No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates. Candidates shall update themselves with the University Website ([www.kuhs.ac.in](http://www.kuhs.ac.in)) and with the University Press releases for the latest

information.
