It is hereby notified the following amendment to the following clauses of Course Regulations of all UG courses, MDS,M.B.B.S, Medicine Super Speciality, Medicine PG, B.Sc Nursing, PB Nursing and M.Sc Nursing Courses being Kerala University of Health Sciences made by the 19th Academic Council meeting held on 09.10.2018, as per Statute 1 of Chapter XXXVI of Kerala University of Health Sciences, which was approved by 49th Governing Council meeting held on 08.11.2018. These amendments have been laid before the Senate held on 14.03.2019, as per Statute 3 of Chapter XXXVI of the Statutes 2013. These amendment shall come in to force with immediate effect.
