



CBME- SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

University Examination	Long Essays 2x15 Marks =30 marks (one should be case based) Short Essays 5x8 Marks = 40 marks Brief Answer/diagrams 5x4 Marks= 20 marks Precise Answers 10x1 Marks = 10 marks Pass criteria University Exam – 50% in theory + practicals , separately (practicals = practicals +viva) In subjects that have two papers, the learner must secure at least 40% marks in each of the papers with minimum 50% of marks in aggregate (both papers together) to pass.
Internal Examinations (IA – Not less than 3 examination in a year. Prior to University examination additional tests may be conducted as and when required.)	Internal Assessment – 100 marks 80 marks – marks scored in exams 20 marks – Professionalism, day to day activities , research, extra curriculum Pass criteria IA – 50% combined in theory and practicals (not less than 40% in each) for eligibility for appearing for University examination Learners must secure at least 50% marks of the total marks (combined in theory and practical / clinical; not less than 40 % marks in theory and practical separately) assigned for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject
