CORRIGENDUM

As per the paper read (1) above, the section 21 Criteria for Promotion in B.Sc MLT course is as follows:-

“The student shall be promoted up to third year irrespective of whether he/she has passed the first, or second year University examinations provided he/she has attained 80% attendance and appeared in all the sessional examinations for both theory and practical in the respective years. But a candidate before appearing for the third year B.Sc (MLT) examination shall have passed in all the subjects of first and second year B.Sc (MLT) examinations. If the candidate fails in the first or second year or both, and third year examinations he/ she will be retained in the third year itself. Though the candidate fails in third year examination, but he or she passed both first and second year shall be promoted to fourth year. The candidate before appearing the fourth year B.Sc(MLT) examination shall have passed in all the subjects of third year B.Sc(MLT).”

As per the paper read (2) above, the Board of Studies had recommended to modify the above clause as follows: -

“The students shall be promoted up to 4th year irrespective of whether he/she has passed the 1st, 2nd or 3rd year University examination, if the student is having required attendance and internal assessment. But the candidate before appearing for the 4th year examination shall have passed in all the subjects of 1st, 2nd and 3rd year examinations”.

The above modifications suggested by the Board of Studies is approved by the Faculty of Paramedical and Allied Health Science in its meeting read (3) above, and the decision of the Faculty of Paramedical and Allied Health Science has been approved by the Academic Council vide paper (4) above. The minutes of the academic council was

approved by the Governing Council and implemented vide order read (5) above.

The Syllabus read (1) above stands modified to this extent.
