Section 3.9 Number of examiners needed (Internal & External) and their qualifications of syllabus of all AYURVEDA VACHASPATHI/ AYURVEDA DHANWANTRI(2016-17 Academic year onwards) courses has been modified as follows:

- i. The preliminary examination and final examination shall be held in written, practical or clinical and oral examination.
- ii. The preliminary examination shall be conducted by a team of two examiners.out of which one examiner shall be from external zone.
- iii. The final examination shall be conducted by a team of four examiners, out of which two examiners shall be external from out of the state. A minimum of 3 examiners should be essential for final PG Examination.
- iv. A teacher with five years teaching or research experience in concerned subject or speciality shall be considered eligible for being appointed as an examiner.
