




# JDT ISLAM COLLEGE OF NURSING, VELLIMADUKUNNU, KOZHIKKODE




# 3. World Oral health day








# LITTLE FLOWER COLLEGE OF NURSING, ANGAMALY


# 3. Report on World Kidney Day


World Water Day was celebrated with various activities at Amala Campus and College of Nursing, focusing on the importance of water conservation and access to clean water for all.







As a part of world Oral Health Day, Oral Hygiene kits were distributed to Non teaching staffs on 20/3/2024 in the presence of Dr. Aarathi Vijayan, HOD and Dr. Saira Siraj E Senior Lecturer, Department of Public Health Dentistry.

An oral screening camp was also conducted by Department of Public Health Dentistry, Azeezia College of Dental Sciences and Research, Kollam and NSS unit (NSS/SFU/KLM/KUHS/3) on 20/3/2024 at Navajeevan Trust (Abhayakendram), Nedumbana. The Navajeevan trust Director Mr. Abdul Majeed addressed the gathering. There were a total of 46 inmates. A total number of 27 inmates including staffs were screened. The other inmates in the trust was bedridden and those who want immediate care was done oral screening.

A kid-sized Mannequin, as a Health Education Aid was inaugurated on 25/3/2024 by honourable Director Dr.Midulaj Azeez and Principal Dr.Radhakrishnan Nair addressed the gathering.















Brief Description of the activity with photographs if any:-

World water day is observed on 22<sup>nd</sup> March to highlight the importance of freshwater and the theme of 2024 is "**leveraging water for peace**". The World water day is observing every year since 1993 is an annual united nation observance focusing on the importance of freshwater. World water day celebrate water and raises awareness of 2.2 billion people lining without access to safe water. It's about taking action to tackle the global crisis. A core four of world water day is to support the achievement of sustainable development goal.

As a part of this day the Department of Public Health Dentistry of Azeezia Dental College of Sciences and Research and NSS unit (NSS/SFU/KLM/KUHS/3) organized a field visit to the water treatment plan on 22-03-24 at 10.30 am , under guidance of Dr. Naveen Jacob Varghese NSS programme officer , Senior Lecturer , Department of Public Health Dentistry.

First, we visited the sewage treatment plant (STP). The supervisor explained about the working of sewage treatment plant. The waste collected is first pass through a screening and pumping process, then grit removal, and primary setting in which good bacteria is added to the sludge. Next the aeration /activated sludge is prepared. Then it is moved on to the secondary setting where small amount of good bacteria are added. Finally filtration of cultured water, disinfection and oxygen takes place. In our college this water is mainly used for gardening purpose

Next the visit was to water treatment plant (WTP), where the step in purification of large scale was explained. First the raw water collected from a mall and big team of river from Adichanaloor which is a branch of Meyanoor in Kollam. The raw water is first treated with chemical coagulant, Alum in a range of 5-40 milligram/ per liter of water. The dose of alum varies depending upon the turbidity, color, temperature and pH of water.

The next step is Mixing in which the treated water is subject to violent agitation in a mixing chamber for few minutes. After that Flocculation is done in a slow and gentle string in flocculation chamber for about 30 minutes. In Sedimentation, it consists of 3 sedimentation tank with a depth of 3.5 m. The Coagulation water is now led into sedimentation tanks where it is detained for 150 minutes. After that Filtration of water by sand bed and gravel support and the filter bottom is done. The backwashing is done twice at 8 am and 5 pm . Finally

Disinfection is done by chlorination. The purified water which was stored in the reservoir is supplied to various places in Azeezia.

The visit gave knowlegde about the purification of water on large scale we came to know about the importance of water purification which was carried in the above steps. In conclusion water treatment plant is an essential process that is critical on protecting our environment and public health .by removing contaminants from waste water, we can reduce the risk of water pollution and spread of water borne diseases.









Brief Description of the activity with photographs if any:-

The Fundamental of right to vote is the right in many democratic nations, including India. It ensures that every citizen has the opportunity to participate in the democratic process, thereby allowing them to have a say in how they are governed. In India, their right is enshined in the constitution under Article 326, which grants every citizen above the age of 18 year the right to vote.





The program was inaugurated by Principal Prof.Dr.Sudheesh. in presents of various faculty members, NSS volunteers and students highlighted the program.






## SANTHIGIRI AYURVEDA MEDICAL COLLEGE PALAKKAD


