ORDER

One of the main objectives of the Kerala University of Health Sciences, as per the KUHS Act, 2010 is to promote research. The University has to promote and facilitate research in the University Schools/ Departments / Centres through the Intramural Research Programme. The services of faculty members who can guide and support research activities is necessary to meet this requirements. Since the University does not have its own constituent colleges, the Academic Council as per read (1) has recommended to recognise all Schools / Departments / Centres of the University as a single unit, till all the Schools / Departments / Centres are individually equipped to become approved Research Centres by itself, as per the norms of the approved PhD regulations of KUHS.

The Governing Council vide read (2) above has approved the proposal of the Academic Council and decided to name the proposed KUHS research unit as KUHS Research Centre.

Functioning of the KUHS Research Centre.

1. Pro Vice Chancellor shall be the academic and administrative Head of the KUHS Research Centre.
2. Faculty of Schools / Departments / Centres/ Academic Staff College/ Academic Statutory officers including University Deans and Emeritus Professors shall be the Faculty/ PhD Guides, if otherwise eligible as per the KUHS PhD Regulations.
3. KUHS Research Centres shall engage Visiting / Adjunct/ Honorary Faculty as per the norms fixed for their appointment by the Academic Council and Governing Council .
4. KUHS Research Centre shall perform all the activities related to the conduct of PhD programme through this centre as stipulated in Clause 4.2 of KUHS PhD Regulations, 2018.





5. Office of the Schools and Centres working at the KUHS Headquarters shall be the administrative office for the KUHS Research Centre. This office will provide the administrative support for the conduct of the programmes and will keep Registers and all other documents related to the PhD programmes.

6. Dean (Research) who is also a member of the faculty of the centre, co-ordinating the PhD programme of the KUHS will guide officers of the schools and centres at KUHS headquarters in all matters related to the academic programs of the PhD aspirants/scholars registered in this research unit.

Considering all these, the University is pleased to accord sanction to establish KUHS Research Centre incorporating all Schools /Academic Staff College / Departments / Centres as a single Unit and to regulate the functioning of the Centre as noted above.
Orders are issued accordingly with retrospective effect from the date of the decision, ie 20-11-2017.
