Duly signed print out of completed online application form, downloaded, along with self attested hard copies of Research Papers and Bonafide Original Certificate of Employment, self attested copies of Experience certificates in proof of the eligibility, as per KUHS PhD regulations 2018, should be submitted to the University for consideration before 13/10/2021.
