The Academic Council had exercised the powers vested upon it vide Sub section (1) (xiii) of section 25 of KUHS Act 4 of 2010 and had fixed the qualifications and norms for appointment of paper –setters, Examiners, moderators (Scrutinizers) and others concerned with the conduct of Examination as follows.

For Medical, Dental, Ayush, Pharmacy and Nursing courses the question paper setters and moderators (scrutinizers) should have 8 years post PG teaching experience for UG Courses and 10 years post PG teaching experience of which 5 years in a PG affiliated institution for PG, super speciality, MPhil and Ph.D courses. For UG courses of Paramedical and allied streams, 3 years post PG teaching experience and for PG courses 5 years post PG teaching experience has been fixed as the qualification. The Academic Council also decided to entrust Controller of Examinations to give concessions if necessary in a case to case manner with the approval of the Vice chancellor.

The 12th meeting of Academic council of KUHS held on 30th June 2016, vide its Agenda 12.24, has considered the matter of chronic failures in the First year examinations of a total of 2971 students in 14 courses of 4 year-duration spread over a number of colleges which makes the students ineligible for appearing for the Final year Examinations within the period of double duration and consequent problems of mercy chance requests e.t.c and other social problems which may be faced in the year 2018 onwards vide paper read as (1) above.

The Academic Council decided to send letters to the Principals of colleges with chronic failure asking them to take remedial measures to improve the performance of such students in the Examinations. The committee also authorized the Vice Chancellor to formulate a committee under Dr.K.K.Purushothaman to suggest remedial measures for tackling the problem.

The 33rd meeting of the Governing Council vide its agenda 33.05 has approved the minutes of the 12th meeting of Academic council

Vide reference (3) cited above, the Honourable Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the decision of the Academic Council with regard to Chronic failures in first year programmes 2010,2011&2012 admissions and formulated a committee under Dr.K.K.Purushothaman for suggesting remedial measures for tackling the problem. Order

The 31st meeting of Governing council of KUHS held on 4th April2016, vide its Agenda 31.14, has considered the decisions of the meeting of the Board of Examinations held on 21.03.2016 with respect to (a) shortage of eligible examiners, (b)shortage of evaluators, (c) retention of practical answer books at exam centres,(d) third valuation and (e) issuance of consolidated mark list for all courses conducted by KUHS and resolved to refer the agenda to Academic Council for a wider discussion vide paper read as (1) above.

The 12 th meeting of Academic Council held on 30.07.2016 had discussed the matter related to the third valuation and issuance of consolidated mark lists vide its agenda 12.26 and recommended to (1) Withdraw the earlier decision to conduct third valuation for the papers secured between 45-49%.(2) to take the average of higher two scores as final mark, (3) to implement the above decisions from the date of approval by Governing Council and (4) to issue consolidated mark lists to candidates (Regular/Supplementary) of all courses on request by payment of requisite fee and to record the number of chances in the consolidated mark list. Vide paper read as (2) above.

The 33rd meeting of Governing Council held on 30.07.2016 has approved the decisions of the Governing Council vide its agenda No. 33.05 and the matter was again referred to Academic Council for want of clarifications regarding the finalisation of marks after third valuation.

The 13th meeting of the Academic Council held on 30.08.2016 has modified and clarified the decision of the Governing Council decision No.33.05 as follows. "In double valuation system for PG courses (wherever applicable) and for all UG course, with regard to 3rd valuation where there is a difference of more than 15% of the total marks in the paper (QP Code Wise) between the two valuations (Provided that the marks obtained for any one of the valuation is 35% or above of the total marks), the average of the highest two marks will be taken as final mark". This decision will be applicable for all examinations notified on or after 30.07.2016.

The 34th meeting of the Governing Council vide its agenda 34.20 has approved the minutes of the 13th meeting of Academic council.

Vide reference (5) cited above, the Honourable Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction to implement the decision of the Academic Council with regard to the modifications in the double valuation system followed by KUHS w.e.f examinations notified on or after 30.07.2016.
